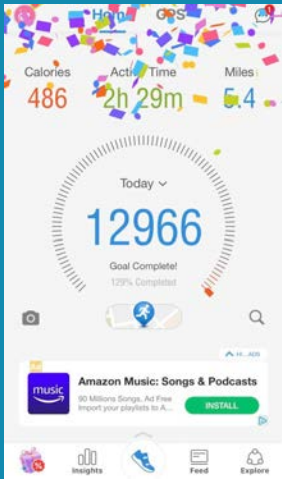

One more year of helping replace the bark on the fitness trail. This year Thad Scholes asked me to oversee the group while he attended the graduation of his grandchild.

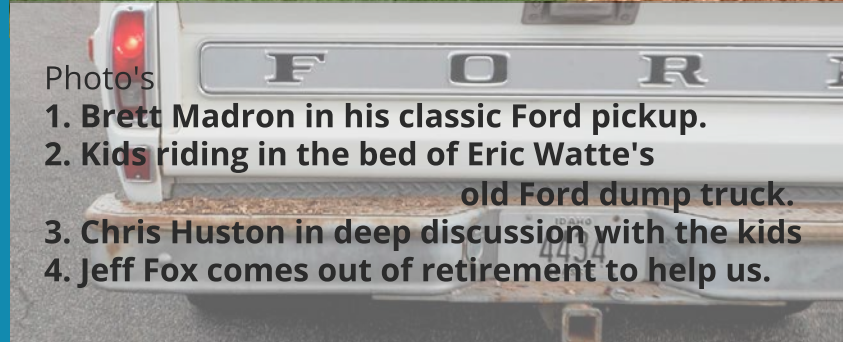
Great day weather-wise and everyone doing their job of driving or supervising our young helpers. Thanks to Robert Stuart's team for helping make this task easier.

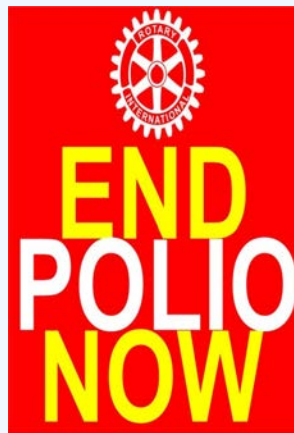
