Request for Financial Assistance

The Rotary Club of Twin Falls (Rotary) holds annual fundraisers each year so it may be able to offer assistance to non-profit organizations (501 C 3) that strive to improve the Twin Falls Community. Its focus is to provide funding for specific projects rather than an organization’s operating or travel or start-up expenses, events, donated funds, scholarships or sponsorships.

The following criteria are used to determine which projects it will fund:

1. Applicants must have a 501 C 3 designation and provide its EIN number;
2. Rotary provides funding for projects which will help multiple people or the community at large;
3. Funds must be used for projects which will improve the Twin Falls Community;
4. List other fund requests that have been submitted for the same project. Include who is funding the project, the amount requested, and when a decision to fund is expected;
5. Rotary funds must be used for a project to be completed in the near future. Funds cannot be used for already completed projects;
6. Organizations that have received funding in the past 15 months will not be considered for funding in this round;
7. If possible, please include acknowledgement of Rotary in any signage or promotion of this project. If a logo is needed, Rotary will provide one.

Rotary disperses funds from its two major fundraisers twice a year. Applications will be accepted **through May 15th** from the Death By Chocolate funds and between **September 1 and September 30** from the Ice Cream Funday funds. Disbursements are made within 60 days of the deadlines.
